HYMN BOOKS - Please return any books that you may have borrowed or mistakenly taken home!

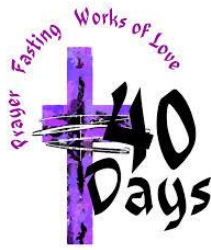
REPAIR & DECORATION

SEASON OF LENT

THE SEASON OF LENT is a time of preparation for the celebration of Easter and there are lots of opportunities available within our parish:

ASH WEDNESDAY on **14th February** is a Day of Fasting and Abstinence, or other act of self-denial. Ashes will be distributed during the 12.00 Mass.

PRAYER FOR THE EARTH

There will be a Vigil outside Parliament from **14th to 23rd February** which is supported by **CAFOD**. They are asking us to offer the prayer from Pope Francis entitled Prayer for the Earth for five minutes on each of these dates. **NB.** There are prayer cards available at the back of church.

FAMILY FAST DAY will be celebrated on **Friday 23rd February**. This year's donations go to CAFOD'S work in Liberia – see the poster at the back of church. Envelopes will be available next weekend and you can donate on-line at cafod.org.uk.

HOLY HOUR with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction on **Sunday 25th Feb at 3.00pm** followed by afternoon tea in the Parish Centre.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be celebrated @ 11.30 before the 12.00 mass each Thursday.
