JUBILEE YEAR 2025 – PILGRIMS OF HOPE – POPE FRANCIS' PRAYER:

A special prayer has been composed for this Jubilee Year and will be recited after the Vigil Mass each Saturday evening at St Joseph's. Prayer cards are available at the back of church so you can say it regularly at home too during the week.

NOVENA TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS:

To mark the Holy Year of Jubilee, you are invited to follow a Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus each First Friday of every month commencing this Friday, 7th February, and ending Friday, 3rd October 2025. This will be recited after our First Friday morning Mass (including any School Masses which may fall on a first Friday of a month). The Novena is printed below so that if anyone is unable to attend Mass that day, they could say the Novena at home. In addition to this devotion, parishioners may wish to attend Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament the previous evening, held each Thursday from 6.30-7.30pm in the Front Room of the Presbytery (main door will be open, first room on the left).

3. O my Jesus, you have said: 'Truly I say to you, heaven and earth will pass away but my words will not pass away.' Encouraged by your infallible words I now ask for the grace of... *(here name your request)*

Our Father... . Hail Mary... . Glory Be to the Father...

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, for whom it is impossible not to have compassion on the afflicted, have pity on us miserable sinners and grant us the grace which we ask of you, through the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, your tender Mother and ours.

Conclude by saying the "Hail, Holy Queen" and add: "St. Joseph, Foster Father of Jesus, pray for us".
